Inserting the inner components

Untie the handstrap and slide down the battery locks to unlock the battery cover.

Use the notch and lift the battery cover. Remove the cover completely.




9 Insert the top of the cover first and then 8 Insert the battery. Make sure the gold press around the edges of the cover until it clicks into place. contacts are aligned.


7 Slide the SAM card into the slot.


Charging the Battery

1 Open the cover of multi-purpose jack.



2 Plug the micro 5-pin end of the charger into the device's multi-purpose jack.

Turning the Device Off



Press and hold the Power button for a few seconds.

- To turn the screen on or off, press the Power button.

Do not turn off the device by removing the battery, as this may damage the device.











Screen Overview
